**Theme: *‘TRA’s 30 Years Achievements and Expectations
for the Next 30 Years’***

INTRODUCTION

This year marks an important milestone for the Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA) as it commemorates 30 years since its establishment in 1996. Since then, it has played a pivotal role as a semi-autonomous government agency overseeing central government revenue administration. TRA has evolved in its structure and operations over time reflecting changes in the operating landscape and the needs to modernize tax administration, improve taxpayer service, enhance compliance, and increase tax revenue mobilization to fund the nation’s development. To date, TRA has recorded significant achievements in improving taxpayer service, simplification of tax administration and compliance and increasing tax revenue hence enabling the Government to increase service provision to the citizenry including health, water, education and infrastructure projects.

As it mark 30 years, TRA has continued to record- breaking revenue collection.

Reflecting on the achievements and experience, TRA still aspires to enhance further revenue compliance and revenue collection as reflected in its mission “We Make It Easy to Pay Tax and Enhance Compliance for Sustainable Development” and its vision to be “A Trusted Revenue Administration for Socio-economic Development”.

As part of 30 years commemorations TRA's Institute of Tax Administration (ITA), has organized the 2nd TRA Tax Symposium as a unique forum that brings together tax experts, renowned academicians, practitioners, policymakers, researchers and other stakeholders to share perspectives regarding tax administration issues. In congruence with this year's theme, the forum ought to discuss, among others, reflections on tax policy reforms, TRA's developments and achievements, as well as stakeholders' insights, experiences and proposal for future direction of tax administration in the next 30 years.
