AJCFS is a biannual, peer-reviewed journal that promotes critical inquiry and publishes high quality theoretical, empirical, and applied research in customs, taxation, fiscal systems, international trade and related fields.

The AJCFS particularly welcomes contributions under the following themes:

- Tax administration and compliance, international taxation and transfer pricing, tax policy and reforms, taxation of specialised sectors, customs modernization and trade facilitation, regional integration and international trade, local government taxation, and emerging issues in customs, taxation, and fiscal policy.

Submitted manuscripts should:

- Be original, unpublished, and not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- Be prepared in English language using Microsoft Word, Times New Roman, 12-point font, single spacing and maximum of 20 A4 pages.
- Follow the journal's prescribed structure: Abstract, Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, findings and Discussion, Conclusion and Implications of the Study.
- Submit editable formats of graphs and charts.
- Conform to the APA (7th Edition) referencing style.
- Be accompanied by a Turnitin or similar plagiarism report with a similarity index of less than 20%.
- Note: The journal editor may request submission of original data and the script or analysis code for transparency.
